



A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR CAROL



Dear Members and Friends,

Do you remember conversation hearts? They're those small, heart-shaped candies with messages stamped on them in red. They were first introduced by the candy company Necco in the 1860's. These pastel-colored candies are ubiquitous around Valentine's Day. According to the Necco website, they make about 100,000 pounds of candy hearts per day, which amounts to billions of tiny candies being produced each year. Necco also changes the messages on the hearts regularly. Classic messages include Be Mine, Hug Me, and Sweet Heart. More updated messages include sayings like Text Me, You Rock, and #Love. Some of the sayings require some careful thought to decipher: URAQT, for example. (Hint: try saying each letter out loud).

A few years ago I started to wonder: What if God created conversation hearts? What messages would God put on them?

I imagine a yellow candy that says, I Vou, for we read God's message in Jeremiah 31:3 "I have loved you with an everlasting love."

Perhaps a purple heart would say, U R Mine, a reminder of Isaiah 43:1: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine."

Maybe there would be a green heart bearing the message I 4give U. We read God's wonderful promise in I John 1:9. *"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."*

Another candy might bear the message, I care 4 U, recalling to mind the words of I Peter 5:7. "Cast all your anxiety on him, for he cares for you."

I can just picture a white candy with Jesus' parting words stamped in red: "I am with you always" (Matthew 28:20).

Well, Necco will probably never print hearts bearing those sayings, but that's okay. We have an entire Bible filled with God's promises. May your heart be strengthened and encouraged by God's unending love for you.


What a great reminder that God's word is a precious, practical gift meant to be opened and reopened regularly.

THE GREATEST LOVE OF ALL






LOVE ALL YOU DO
