A Message From Pastor Carol

This fall, we've been looking at some of the names and titles for God that we read in the Bible. The name for God that is used most frequently is Yahweh, often translated in English Bibles as LORD. This name is closely associated with the words God spoke to Moses from the burning bush.

God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." This is what you are to say to the Israelites I AM has sent me to you.

Now as names go, I AM WHO I AM is pretty enigmatic. Scholars have puzzled over its meaning for millennia. The Hebrew phrase can be translated about a dozen different ways in English. I AM WHO I AM is the most common translation, though it can also be translated I WILL BE WHO I WILL BE or I WILL BE WHO I AM. That clears things right up, doesn't it?

This divine name is used 6,828 in Holy Scripture, and yet its exact meaning remains something of a mystery. According to one preacher, "It is as if God is saying, Don't box me in." (David Lose) I AM bigger and greater and more powerful than you can ever imagine. Old Testament scholar Terrance Freitheim expressed what many of us have experienced: "The more one understands of God, the more mysterious God becomes."

One Jewish source I consulted offered these ways of understanding the divine name: "I am and remain present; I exist and fulfill my promises; I will be what tomorrow demands." I AM reminds us that God is with us and for us - past, present, and future. I AM is all we need and so much more! If you are struggling today, be encouraged by the fact that God is the great I AM. No matter what we may face now or in the future, I AM will see us through.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- ❖ Doors will open at 10:15. A greeter will open the door for you.

DURING THE SERVICE

- ❖ The service will be held in the sanctuary. Please sit in seats marked with a yellow cross.
- During the summer, families will worship together.
- Services will be shorter and planned with all ages in mind.
- Because it's difficult to sing while wearing masks, we're going to avoid congregational singing and focus on instrumental and solo pieces.
- We will share the peace of Christ from our seats using a touchless greeting.
- ❖ The viewing gallery will be open for one family per week on a first-come, first-served basis. The changing table in the nursery will also be available.

GIVING

- ❖ An offering plate will be available to place your offering in as you enter the sanctuary.
- ❖ You may mail your offering to 203 S. Michigan Ave. Saginaw, MI 48602

DURING COMMUNION

- On the first Sunday of the month, communion is available in prepackaged cups. You will be given one as you arrive.
- Drop your used communion cup in the waste basket by the door as you exit.

AFTER SERVICE

- You will be dismissed by rows.
- Feel free to linger in the parking lot and visit while observing social distancing.


