A Message From Pastor Carol

Do you have a favorite passage (or passages) of Scripture? Are there some Bible verses that you turn to again and again for hope, strength and support? Without a doubt, some of my favorite verses come from Romans 8.

It begins:

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus. It concludes:

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our LORD.

I can't tell you how many times I have turned to those promises for comfort and encouragement.

Some call Romans 8 "the greatest chapter in the Bible." As one commentator noted, "It begins with no condemnation and ends with no separation." The verses in between are filed with wonderful truths about our status as children of God and the glorious hope that we have in Christ.

The Sunday after Easter we will begin a 6 week sermon series on Romans 8. Whether you join us in person or watch the services online, you will want to be a part of this uplifting series.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- ❖ Doors will open at 10:15. A greeter will open the door for you.
- Please put on your mask before entering the building. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided.
- Please enter only through the Adams Street entrance (by the chairlift).
- Please use only touchless greetings.
- Your temperature will be checked with a touchless thermometer.
- We will be social distancing so try to stay 6' apart and keep hallways clear.
- ❖ The unisex bathrooms on the sanctuary level are available. They will be cleaned after each use.

DURING THE SERVICE

- ❖ The service will be held in the sanctuary. Please sit in seats marked with a yellow cross.
- During the summer, families will worship together.
- Services will be shorter and planned with all ages in mind.
- Because it's difficult to sing while wearing masks, we're going to avoid congregational singing and focus on instrumental and solo pieces.
- ❖ We will share the peace of Christ from our seats using a touchless greeting.





Maundy Thursday April 1, 2021 7:00 P.M. Fellowship Hall


We will gather for a brief communion service followed by time spent working on a community service project. We will be packing Easter goody bags for residents of a local care home.




