A Message From Pastor Carol

The holidays will soon be upon us. As many of you know, I collect nativity sets from around the world. I purchase my sets through fair trade organizations; however, occasionally I'll check e-bay to see if they have any nice "vintage" global nativity sets for sale. Last year I came across a beautiful ebony set that had been carved in Africa. It featured ornately carved magi, shepherds and their sheep, Mary and Joseph. All the characters were exquisitely done in a unique African style, and the price was reasonable. I was considering purchasing it, when I realized something was off. I reread the description and looked again. The set featured Mary and Joseph, the shepherds and their sheep, four ornately carved magi, but right there in the fine print it said, "missing Jesus." There was no babe lying in a manger. Somehow Jesus had gotten separated from the set. Well, I couldn't buy a nativity set that was missing the main character. I'll have to keep looking for an ebony set from Africa. But the e-bay posting got me thinking. Let's not miss Jesus this Christmas. In the midst of all our holiday traditions - the cookie baking, the decorating, the gift giving, the trips to the mall, the holiday concerts, let's take care that we not forget the real reason for the season. Jesus is the one we worship and honor. Let's keep him the focus, not just for the holiday season, but all through the year.

This year we will have over 30 handcrafted nativities on display in the sanctuary representing over two dozen countries. The nativities each depict the good news of Christmas in a unique way appropriate to the culture they represent. The nativities range in size from less than 2 inches high to a foot tall. They are made from a variety of materials: wood, clay, cloth, papier mache, stone, and more unique materials like cornhusks and banana leaves. The nativities will be on display during the four Sundays of Advent (November 28 - December 19). My hope is that seeing the variety of nativities will help us contemplate the birth of Christ in new ways and be astounded again at the wonder of God becoming human and coming to live among us.
